5. Operating revenues, expenses and rounds report – OB Sports

A. FY21/22 - Mr. Palmgren reported rounds were about 5% ahead of budget. Revenues were solid across the board, especially with the 7 days of deals. Projects, repairs and large expenses negatively impacted the budget finishing about \$40k behind budget NOI and \$150k behind budget for the year.

6. 7 Days of deals—OB Sports

Mr. Palmgren explained the popular deals and the marketing campaign that gained a lot of momentum. Golf Cash generated \$321,000 on Christmas Eve alone. The annual memberships sold systemwide in December at \$269,000.

7. Tucson Golf Program

Mr. Lewis provided details on the new program and mentioned numerous participants are registered for the current three-week session and the upcoming eight-week session called Operation 36. In addition, the PGA Family Cup, random clinics, Practice Club, PGA Junior League and upcoming summer camps for kids are planned and mentioned that there has been a lot of interest in the program and positive feedback.
