1. It is imperative that the Historic Zone Advisory Boards [HZABs] retain their design review powers because of the unique character and significance of each of the five (5) Historic Preservation Zones and the special knowledge and expertise that only residents of those communities can bring.

- 2. The physical splitting of the commissions—if it is deemed to be necessary—be accomplished with a simple text amendment.
- 3. To call for an administrative local study (which was discussed) documenting the strengths and weaknesses of the HZABs and the TPCHC.
- 4. Based on that local study, that there be a comprehensive, impartial, transparent process to implement improvements to the existing HZAB and City Historical Commission review process.
