2. Approval of the August 3, 2022, IAPC Meeting Minutes

3. Staff Update

Johanna Hernandez, Business Services Deputy Director, provided an update to the commission. The update included information on the implementation of Workday, the \$25 million grant that the city received for improvements to the 22nd Street bridge, the finalizing of the fiscal year 2023 budget and the progress on the fiscal year 2022 Annual Financial Comprehensive Report. Commissioners asked if there was a contract yet for the 22nd Street bridge and asked about the timeline for the Workday implementation. No action taken.

4. Code Enforcement Subcommittee Update

Internal Auditor, Leah Bird, provided an update to the commission on the last subcommittee meeting, which was held on August 24th. The subcommittee is in the final editing stages for their report. The next meeting has not yet been scheduled. No action taken

5. American Rescue Plan Act Funding Update

Johanna Hernandez, Business Services Deputy Director, provided an update to the commission on the APRA funding. She showed the commissioners the new webpage the city is launching where citizens will be able to find information regarding ARPA.

Chairperson Clark led a discussion on future agenda items. Items included the presentation from the police department, which is scheduled for next month, updates on filling the vacancies on the commission, and time for the commissioners to discuss the report on the street furniture contract they received.
