- Mr. Jesse briefly discussed the PSPRS June 30, 2022 actuarial valuation results for Tucson Fire and Tucson Police. Those results determine the FY 2024 employer contribution rates. The Tier 1/Tier 2 employer contribution rates effective July 1, 2023 (FY 2024) will be 76.58% for Fire and 93.28% for Police. The Tier 3 employer contribution rates will be 72.95% for Fire and 91.70% for Police.
