Ms. Rosenberry asked for background information that would clarify the steps involved in applications for disability benefits. Mr. Bossé provided an explanation of the required actions for disability benefit applications.

#### 8. FUND/OFFICE INFORMATION

#### Miscellaneous / Other

Mr. Jesse stated with the recent passing of HB 2808, the employee contribution rate will decrease for all Tier 2 members and a small subset of Tier 1 members. Before HB 2808 was passed, those members were subject to an 11.65% employee contribution rate. Their new employee contribution rate will be 7.65% effective July 1, 2023. Thus, the employee contribution rate is now consistent for all members in Tiers 1 and 2.

Mr. Jesse also mentioned the extra 4% that Tier 2 members and a subset of Tier 1 members had been contributing was allocated to a Maintenance of Effort fund that was prohibited from being used to reduce employer unfunded liability. HB 2808 lifted that restriction. As a result, revised June 30, 2022 actuarial reports were generated. Mr. Jesse had already provided a contribution rate exhibit, based on the original actuarial valuation results, to the parties at City Hall tasked with updating the payroll system for FY 2024 rates. He subsequently updated that exhibit to reflect the results of the revised June 30, 2022 actuarial valuations and provided it to the same parties that had received the original contribution rate exhibit.

Ms. Rosenberry told board members that Mike Townsend, PSPRS Executive Director, would be making a presentation during a Mayor and Council Study
