## 8. Energy Manager Report

Energy Manager Michael Catanzaro gave a progress report on citywide solar installations. The City has installed solar at 58 sites totaling more than 15MW of energy. That is more than 40,000 solar panels for context. This has made a significant impact on reducing GHG emissions with an official report coming out this summer.

He also gave an overview of the energy office, and the more than 5,000 accounts the office is responsible for tracking with a total spend of more than \$30M.
