#### 1. CALL TO ORDER

• Meeting called to order at 3:30 p.m. by R.van Ommeren; verbal roll call – 6 members present, quorum present (A.Meadow arrived at 3:38 p.m.)

#### 3. Discussion

Welcome to 2 new members: Eric Dhruv, Educator and Petr Chylik, Landscape Contractor.

- A. Blue Palo Verde Protocol: N.Shipley recapped discussion with U.Schuch and J.Brown from UArizona Ag-Extension; establishing/requiring nurseries to have growing protocol for Blue Palo Verde; potential for City of Tucson to request nursery protocol and/or developing an approved list of growers based on their protocol; Committee recommendation have City look at LAC recommendation of what should be included in nursery growing protocol for Blue Palo Verde; motion by J.Moscato, second by D.Davis.; motion passed yes=7; no=0; abstain=0
- B. RWH rebate update (metric collection): presented by I.Ogata: basic calculations now required for RWH rebate explanation of built-in calculator; better metric estimates of RWH volumetric capture by earthworks; discussion of positive movement to install earthworks and removal of cap on earthworks to encourage more basin development
- C. LAC ad hoc committees: no new development from Plant List Committee: re-confirming members interested to be involved: Darbi Davis, Nichole Casebeer, Rebeca Fields, Jenny Moscato, Eric Dhruv
- D. City Updates: (i) from N.Gillette: implementing Tree Action Plan, 6 month next steps; Awarded IRA grant of \$5M that includes multiple partnership workforce development, equity, maintenance, training; have not spoken with USDA as yet regarding award, current budget is set; potential for committee input if action plan changes in next iterationl (ii) X.Coronado-Vargas: 3 projects under construction Ironwood Horse Park, Neighborhood Center El Rio, Ward 1 targeting celebration in Dec, Lora Lyndon Park off

Escalante, stormwater into parking lot landscape with curb cuts; working with contractors on how to install GSI, involving contractors with training/learning opportunities by teaming new contractors with companies that are experienced with installation; maintenance contract have landscape contractors with experience and/or have gone through Smartscape program; but may need to expand workforce
