Mr. Brandt stated he would be retiring at the end of next month. Thus, the December 7, 2023 Police Board meeting will be his last. He said he is going to work for a non-profit organization that works with first responders and veterans. Mayor Romero congratulated Mr. Brandt on the wonderful opportunity and thanked him for his time serving as a member of the Police Board.

Mr. Jesse indicated a special election would be needed to fill the Police Board seat Mr. Brandt will be vacating upon his retirement. Mr. Jesse then pondered checking with PSPRS headquarters on that given the proximity to the next regular election due to Mr. Brandt's term ending in June 2024 anyway. Mr. Bossé said that the vacancy needed to be filled and that the special election process should be started immediately. He felt that correspondence could be sent now to provide notice of the vacancy and to solicit nominations to run for the abbreviated term. The hope would be to schedule the vote in December and possibly have a new Police Board member seated by January for the remainder of the term.

Mr. Jesse felt that the timeline suggested would not be sufficient to complete the necessary steps as the required secret ballot process is done by mail. Mayor Romero asked Mr. Jesse if it was possible to ask TPD HR to get a notification announcement sent via email to all commissioned personnel. Mr. Jesse said he would coordinate with them to send a group email with the Solicitation for Nominees and Candidates Application attached and move forward with the special election preparations.
