6. Tucson Police Department:

- B. Capt. Tim Reese stated a new sergeant started this week. Detective Eli Chan is also leaving the unit and they're in the process of getting a replacement detective. Capt. Reese also announced he will be retiring and will no longer be involved with CPARB. He also stated starting January 2024 all files will be going from paper to digital.

7. Office of Independent Police Auditor

Mitch updated the commission on the complaints he's been receiving which included the homeless population issues, poor response times from TPD and time it takes to receive police reports. TPD body-worn footage is taking anywhere from 1 year to 1.5 years to get. Mitch also reminded the commission to pursue their 40 hours of training recommended for CPARB.

The report was given by Mitch Kagen, Independent Police Auditor. Discussion was held, no action was taken.

8. CPARB Vacancies

Chair Calhoun reiterated Carlos Portillo is eager to return after his recovery and to become a full voting member of CPARB.

9. Discussion with the City Attorney's Office: Roi Lusk

Roi Lusk stated that CPARB has to vote to have hybrid meetings on the agenda, which must be in city facilities or facilities that have capabilities to accommodate people online and in person. Members must notify City Clerk's office preferably 48 hours prior to meeting that they will be appearing electronically. The Minutes, and Legal Action Reports must make note of who appears electronically and in person. At the beginning of the meeting the chair must state if members are appearing electronically. Chair Calhoun would like to request to have a hybrid meeting format for 2024. The public must be able to attend the meeting, if a commission member has an emergency day of the meeting, accommodations can be made.

Chair Calhoun wants to keep meeting dates for 2024 the same as the 2023 calendar year which is the third Tuesday of every month at 5:30 pm
