#### 6. Committee Reports

#### a. Southern Arizona Veteran's Affairs Health Care System (SAVAHCS)

Jennifer Gutowski, Director of SAVAHCS provided a report on behalf of SAVAHCS.

Discussion was held, and no action was taken.

#### b. Arizona Veterans' Memorial Cemetery

Committee Member Louis reported Sierra Vista had 28 interments last month. He also noted there they would participate in the Races Across America. Marana Cemetery had 31 Interments, and a family who sponsored would be at the Races as well. Commission Byron stated that 1,782 wreaths were purchased as of the November 14<sup>th</sup> meeting.

#### c. Arizona Department of Veterans' Services

Committee Member Louis stated last month they had their annual BBC Conference; new counselors were able to meet their fellow BBC. In-person appointments are on Tuesdays and Thursdays, and 332 claims were submitted.
