Ms. Gutowski mentioned that the stakeholder's report was sent out and wanted to touch base on the Tucson Rodeo and she also mentioned that they are doing V's National Salute to Veteran patients during the week of Valentine's Day so there has been a lot of special events at the hospitals.

Ms. Gutowski mentioned there were new eligibility guidelines for Veterans Affairs (VA) healthcare for World War 2 (WW2) veterans. She stated the new guidelines were a product of the Cleland-Dole Act signed into law in 2022, which expanded eligibility for VA care for WW2 veterans. She encouraged previous applicants who were declined to reapply.
