- a. Office of Senator Mark Kelly – Arlethe Rios**

b. Southern Arizona Veteran's Affairs Health Care System (SAVAHCS)

Jennifer K. Wasielewski, a member of SAVAHCS, provided a report on behalf of SAVAHCS.

Jennifer mentioned that on Friday November 15, 2024, the V.A is hosting a health fair in the Rose Garden, with a Veteran Town Hall to follow at 2:30 p.m. that is in person and virtual. The V.A is expanding the emergency department, and construction will be starting very soon. There will be a lot of signs to follow to get around the V.A. Jennifer also mentioned that the V.A. is trying to get more Veteran's enrolled so that they are covered fully if they need any care from the V.A. even if they have their own insurance, it is best to be enrolled with the V.A.

c. Arizona Veterans' Memorial Cemetery

Committee Member Louis mentioned that there were 70 internments last month at the Marana Cemetery. Committee Member Hollis said she attended a meeting on Tuesday, November 12, 2024 and there are actually 70 internments 70 Military and 9 dependents leaving 4, 961 total internments for the year.

d. Arizona Department of Veterans' Services

Committee Member Louis mentioned that there are four itinerary site locations where a Veteran can make an appointment to be seen in person, there are about four in Tucson. There were about five events in the past few months and have about 1,200 maintaining a 97% approval rate.

e. Military Lounge

Committee Member Byron stated that James Robertson emailed her that Operation Exodus is going to be December 20th through December 23rd, 2024. January 2nd through January 4th, 2025 they are expecting about 1,500 Soldiers during that time frame which is less than last year.

f. Memorial for Vietnam Veteran Memorial Park

Committee Member Byron mentioned that Pima County will be taking over the Gold Star Mother Park and she will be sending City Clerk Staff information about the insurance for the park.
