3. Discussion/debrief regarding August 17, 2024, event at the Presidio Museum (Discussion/Action)

Discussion was held regarding the event. Approximately 638 people attended. More programs will need to be printed for the 2025 event. Commissioner Kubish noted that the event was very crowded. Commissioner Riojas suggested that next year it might be necessary to close the street and noted that

firing of the muskets is better than firing the cannon. She also noted that for 2025 maybe two stages will be needed, and suggested opening with Gertie and the TO Boyz. Commissioner Lamb commented that she loved the Yaqui dancers, but for a public event, the entertainment has to occur in shorter segments. Ken Karrel suggested parking at the legal offices across the street. Amy Hartmann-Gordon noted that the biggest budget item is the band. No action was taken.

4. Celebrate Tucson calendar initiative, website, potential calendar submissions, Indigenous spelling of Tucson (Discussion/Action)

Discussion was held. Amy Hartmann-Gordon said that we should do another promotion to our lists along with personal invitations to submit items for the calendar. No action was taken.
