Commissioner Hollis informed the committee about events being held, one of them being Missing in America on Saturday, April 12, 2025, at 10 a.m. and there will be a Golf Tournament being hosted at Randolph Park on June 14, 2025, starting at 10 a.m.

c. Military Lounge and Operation Exodus

Commissioner Tunks mentioned again the 25th Annual Nighthawk 72 Memorial Service for the 19 Marines who lost their lives at the Marana Regional Airport. The ceremony is scheduled for April 5th, 2025, at 10 a.m. with a candlelight ceremony to follow at 8 p.m.
