a. Jennifer Gutowski, Southern Arizona Veterans Affairs Health Care System - Maria Nguyen, The Associate Director at the Southern Arizona Veterans Affairs Medical Center was in for Ms. Gutowski. Ms. Nguyen informed the committee about the women's Town hall meeting that focused on mental health that was held by the VA last week with over 800 attendees. The VA's outreach team also participated in the Tucson Veterans Serving Veterans Stand Down event providing resources and support to local veterans. Ms. Nguyen invited the committee to the Yuma Veterans Engagement town hall scheduled for March 20, 2025, at the VFW Post 1763 in Yuma, Arizona, and the VA's outreach team will be attending the Yuma Military Appreciation Day which will be held on March 22[,] 2025, honoring military veterans in the region. The Kaakopa Tribal Stand Down will be on March 29, 2025, to continue their commitment to support veterans across all communities. Ms. Nguyen concluded by informing the committee of the Vietnam Veterans Memorial Service on March 28, 2025, at the Tucson Main Campus at the Tucson VA from 11:30 am to 12:30 pm in the "Rose Garden" to honor and remember the sacrifices of Vietnam Veterans.
