The appellant, Heather Dukes, Esq., on behalf of Swan-Isabel, LL and O's and House – Sahuaro, is appealing the Zoning Administrator's Determination (The CMP 0724-00095), issued January 27, 2025, relating to the restriction on the number of residents allowed at the Oxford House. Pursuant to UDC Article 1.5.1.E., marty of record an appeal the zoning determination. The appellant contends that "portions of the intermediation which limit the number of residents and impose "group dwelling" zoning and commercial building code standards to properties with more than eight residents.
