#### 3. <u>Introduction of Guests – Update/Discussion</u>

## a. Maria Nguyen, Southern Arizona Veterans Health Care System

Ms. Nguyen went over the SAVAHCS September 2025 Directors Report and gave a brief update on some of the events the Tucson VA was hosting that she wanted to highlight, which was the 16<sup>th</sup> Annual Gathering of American Indian Veterans, the Women's Veteran Virtual Town Hall, the POW/MIA Ceremony and the Fisher House Open House – Zack Fisher Birthday. Ms. Nguyen concluded her report by providing an update on the VA patient portal transition and the status of the renovations to the mental health building at the Tucson VA.

Ms. O'Shea provided a brief introduction on herself and her background and explained to the committee what the Gift Horse is about and the type of service they offer veterans at no cost, Ms. O'Shea concluded by providing her contact information to the committee.

#### 4. Approval of Legal Action Report for May 14, 2025

# 5. Treasurer's Report

Commissioner Byron reported for May the Veterans Affairs Committee had a beginning balance of \$1921.72, the committee received 2 donations from the BBA106 for \$1000.00 and from the American Legion Auxiliary 68 for \$100.00 leaving the committee an ending balance of \$3021.72 in May. There was no activity in June. For July the payment cleared for the band playing at the Four Chaplains bringing the VAC's end balance to \$2,871.72. There was no activity in August, and nothing is expected for September.

It was moved by Commissioner Hayes, duly seconded, and passed by a roll call vote of 9 to 0, to approve the financial report as presented.

No discussion was held, and no formal action was taken.

### 6. <u>Committee Reports</u>

### a. Arizona Veterans' Memorial Cemetery

Commissioner Hollis provided a brief update to the committee informing them there are currently 5,479 interred including both veterans and their dependents, she also informed the committee Sean Funn from the Missing in America Project has now retired and relocated to Texas.

No discussion was held, and no formal action was taken.

#### b. Arizona Department of Veterans' Services

Commissioner Byron informed the committee that the ADB's has an officer at the Tucson VA Building 13, about 2-3 days a week assisting veterans with scheduling appointments.

#### c. Military Lounge and Operation Exodus

Commissioner Byron informed the committee there is currently no update on the Military Lounge. Commissioner Byron also informed the committee she is scheduled to meet with the Fort Huachuca officer on October 8, 2025, and will have more information on Operation Exodus following that meeting.

No discussion was held, and no formal action was taken.

## d. Four Chaplains Ceremony 2026

Commissioner Byron informed the committee that the Four Chaplains Ceremony is scheduled for 1 p.m. on February 1, 2025, at the Kino Veterans Memorial Park, additional information to follow.

Commissioner Byron has been communicating with Arizona Wine Collective to possibly host a wine tasting event to raise money for the Veterans' Affairs Committee possibly in November or December, more information to follow.

#### 11. <u>Veteran's Day Parade / Memorials – Update/Discussion</u>

Commissioner Byron informed the committee that the Veteran's Day Parade is scheduled for November 11, 2025, celebrating 250 years of Military Service, registration is now open at Tucsonvdpf.org until October 31,2025.
