**LEGAL ACTION REPORT**

- 1. Call to Order/Roll Call** – Commission Chair E. Liane Hernandez called the meeting to order at 5:41 p.m. Roll call was taken, and quorum was established, 7-1.

- 2. Approval of Minutes – October 23, 2025** – Commission member Dale Calvert made a motion to approve the October 23, 2025 meeting minutes as submitted. Commission member Cynthia Harper-Ayala seconded the motion. **The meeting minutes were approved by unanimous voice vote.**
- 3. Call to the Audience (10 minutes)** – No speaker request cards were received.
- 4. Prop 101 Updates** – Mr. DeGroot provided updates on arterial roadway projects, including completed downtown segments, coordination of future work to reduce disruption, construction updates on Park Avenue, Fifth Street, South Valencia Road, and a financial

update indicating projected program overage of approximately \$704,000. Mr. DeGroot revisited the approved motion that passed during the October 2025 meeting, and confirmed consistency with Truth in Taxation requirements. **No action was taken.**

a. Revenue Report

5. **Prop 411 Updates** – Program Manager Jim DeGroot presented updates on projects under construction and mobilizing, projects preparing for bid, coordination with utilities, pavement condition improvements, Phase One progress, before-and-after visuals, and revenue updates. Discussion was held. **No action was taken.**
6. **Collector Street Program Update** – Staff presented updates on completed collector projects, projects in construction, projects in design, and cost management strategies. A request was made to include a future agenda item reviewing roadway reclassifications and their impacts. **No action was taken.**
7. **Arterial and Collector Street Needs** – Mr. DeGroot provided an informational presentation on potential roadway projects contingent upon voter approval of the RTA Next plan. Discussion included methodology, pavement condition data, geographic distribution, and the Commission’s future role in recommendations. **No action was taken.**
8. **Recommendation to Improve Isolated Streets Near University of Arizona** – Mr. DeGroot requested consideration of adding certain isolated street segments near the University of Arizona to active projects for efficiency and potential long-term maintenance transfer to the University. Commissioners discussed timing, coordination, and project benefits. Commission Member Bruce Burke motioned to approve the recommendation as presented. Commission Member Ian Johnson seconded the motion. **Motion passes unanimously.**
9. **Complete Streets Coordinating Council (CSCC) Update** – Mr. DeGroot presented detailed information on the progress of the Collector Street Program, including completed collectors and collectors in construction. In addition, Mr. DeGroot provided updates on collector design progress, collectors in bid or preparing for bid, and upcoming collector projects. He also gave financial information on Collector Program costs. **No action was taken.**
10. **Future meeting Date and Agenda items** - Commissioners discussed when the next meeting would be held and agreed on Monday, March 23, 2026, at 5:30 p.m., subject to room availability.
11. **Adjournment** - Commission Chair E. Liane Hernandez adjourned the meeting at 7:20 p.m.
