Legal Action Report

1. Call to Order/Roll Call

A quorum was established. Members present: Dale Calvert (*Park Tucson Commission*), Zach Coble (*Commission on Disability Issues – CODI representative*), Marshall Davis (*co-chair, DTM Director's Office representative*), Ariel Gilbert-Knight (*Ward 2 representative*), Cytllalli Gonzalez (*Mayor's Office representative*), Josué Licea (*Ward 5 representative*), Samuel Paz (*non-voting, Pima County representative*). Members absent: Sophia Gonzalez (*co-chair, Ward 1 representative*), Nikita Lindgren (*City Manager's Office representative*). **Co-chair Marshall Davis called the meeting to order at 5:33 p.m.**

2. Approval of Minutes: December 10, 2025, CSCC Meeting and January 15, 2026, CSCC Special Meeting

A motion was made by co-chair Marshall Davis, to approve the minutes for both the December 10, 2025, CSCC Meeting and January 15, 2026, CSCC Special Meeting, duly seconded by acting co-chair Ariel Gilbert-Knight, with no corrections; all **approved**.

3. Call to the Audience

No speakers.

4. RTA Next Letter Discussion

Continuation of the discussion related to drafting a letter in response to the RTA Next initiative. DTM staff provided responses to questions posed at the January 15 CSCC Special Meeting, followed by co-chair Davis leading the discussion on the draft letter. Conversations and revisions to the draft letter ensued but ultimately **no formal action was taken**. The item will be continued to the February CSCC for final review and consideration.

5. **Funding Request: 6th Av Shared Use Path Extension**
Presentation from DTM Senior Project Manager Collin Chesston for a funding request for the reconstruction of a portion of an existing shared use path that runs along the east side of 6th Av just south of 7th St.

A discussion was held, and a **motion was made by co-chair Marshall Davis, duly seconded, to approve up to \$200K in Prop 411 Safety funding to support the project: all approved.**

6. **Spot Safety Improvement Program Update**
Presentation from DTM Traffic Engineering Administrator Blake Olofson to provide an update on the \$1.4M allocation for small safety projects across the city. A brief discussion ensued, and **no formal actions were taken.**

7. **Safety Presentation Preparation**
Members discussed two topics, the first was the option to have the March CSCC Meeting in-person (rather than virtual) and the second was gauging interest in having a representative from the DTM Director's Office to provide a presentation on roadway safety. A discussion ensued and there was consensus among the group to advance both an in-person event and a presentation on safety from the Director's Office. Staff will return at the February Meeting with more information, **no formal action was taken.**

8. **CSCC Hub Updates**
- a) *Park Tucson Commission* – New Director; recent Public Hearing on parking rate increases, delayed vote due to public concerns
 - b) *Tucson Transit Advisory Committee (TTAC)* – no member / update
 - c) *Bicycle Advisory Committee (BAC)* – Update on safety on the Loop (TPD + Sherriff's Office), currently no plans to increase enforcement; interest from BAC to add speed limit signage to the Loop, discussion will be continued; BAC is also considering drafting a response to the RTA Next initiative
 - d) *Commission on Disability Issues (CODI)* – Update from IT on federal compliance/accessibility requirements for municipal websites; sidewalk accessibility and maintenance may be a future discussion item
 - e) *Independent Oversight and Accountability Commission (IOAC)* – no member / update

Reports given as noted; **no action taken.**

9. **Updates and Future Agenda Items**
Included a report out on DTM project updates citywide and a discussion of future agenda items. **No action taken.**
