LEGAL ACTION REPORT

1. Call to Order and Roll Call

Chair Ron Spark called the meeting to order at 5:33 p.m.

Commissioners- John Anderson, Willie Blake, and Harold Coleman were absent.

2. Call to Audience-

The Commission received feedback on the Alamo Wash Greenway program from various community members. Some raised concerns about safety and the potential impact on green spaces and trees, while others expressed support for the program, particularly in relation to its alignment with certain project goals.

3. Approval of January 12, 2026, Meeting Minutes

Commissioner Kathy Kretschmer made a motion to approve the January 12, 2026, meeting minutes.

Vice Chair Krista Romero-Cardenas seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously with all committee members in favor, carrying by roll call vote, 7-0.

4. Palo Verde Park

In response to a constituent inquiry regarding the conditions and maintenance initiatives at Palo Verde Park, the agenda item was discussed, with Administrator Jasmine Chan providing an update. The Palo Verde Park's construction, delayed to October 2025, now has improved irrigation, recovering Bermuda grass, upgraded lighting and accessibility, open restrooms and playgrounds, and a restriped basketball court. The basketball court is closed currently through May 2026 for a hardcover canopy installation.

Chair Ron Spark advised on the dissemination of the report to the individuals who expressed concerns and recommended sending it to residents in the surrounding area.

5. Alamo Wash Greenway Update

Project Manager Collin Chesston shared a full update on the Alamo Wash Greenway program, covering the timelines, analyses, opportunities and constraints, community engagement findings, costs, and recommended alignment.
