2. Approval of Minutes: February 25, 2026, CSCC Meeting

DTM staff presented a request for \$1M in Prop 411 Safety Funds to support citywide sidewalk spot repairs and a framework for prioritizing repairs based on need and equity considerations.

The group discussed prioritization, repeat repair locations, material reuse, and data needs. The item was tabled to allow staff to return with additional information, including a prioritized project list and further analysis.
