In the Spring, PCTWC was awarded a TeamUp Grant from the Community Foundation of Southern Arizona to work with a non-profit consultant and develop a strategic plan. The Commission gathered for an all-day planning retreat facilitated by Cheryl House, getting to know each other better on a personal and professional level. PCTWC walked away with goals, objectives and strategies to focus on for the next five years, which Commissioners review at every meeting.

One such goal has been an effort to develop the infrastructure needed to be effective. Huge strides have been made in improving digital documentation storage and communication, solidifying processes and delegating the work among the Commissioners. PCTWC launched a brand new website in 2025, and new branding is in the works. The Commission has also made improvements to its building, making long-needed repairs and repainting the exterior. Additional improvements are planned for 2026.

The Commissioners have continued to build upon the success of Subcommittees to continue to work outside of monthly meetings. In addition to the Website/Social Media, Strategic Planning, and Domestic Violence Resources subcommittees, the Commission added a Building Maintenance subcommittee and a Nominating subcommittee to focus on recruitment.
