

A quorum of the Civil Service Commission (CSC) of the City of Tucson met on Wednesday, July 15, 2026, at 9:09 AM for a Quarterly Meeting. It was held in the First Floor Conference Room of City Hall at 255 W. Alameda St., Tucson, AZ. It was made accessible remotely through technological means as permitted under Arizona law as well as in person.

1. Call to Order / Roll Call: Present were Chairperson Paul Fimbres, Vice Chairperson Rebeca Montaña, and Commission members Michael Mathieu and Paula Wilk. Also present were Donna Aversa, Legal Counsel to the CSC; Dr. Teri Traaen, Human Resource Director and CSC Secretary; Robert Stevenson, Human Resources Staff Assistant and CSC Recording Secretary; City of Tucson Human Resources Department Deputy Directors Helen Smart and Emely Taylor; and Lupe Garcia, Principal Assistant City Attorney, City Attorney's Office.
2. Call to Audience: No one addressed the Commission.
3. The Chairperson tabled items #4, #5, and #7. The Commission requested the Recording Secretary reformat items #4 and #5 before they are approved. Item #7 may be discussed at a future Civil Service Commission meeting, per the Chairperson.
4. Update on Civil Service Commission Vacancy: HR Director Teri Traaen updated the Commission on the search to fill its current vacancy. Dr. Traaen has been communicating with the City Clerk's Office and the Mayor's Office about an appointment to fill the vacancy. Dr. Traaen said the HR Department will update Commission members by the end of the week if the nomination moves forward on the August 5, 2026, Mayor and Council agenda.
